Crack addicts also exhibit a higher loss of life expectancy than other drug addicts. In a study that followed crack users for 15 years, researchers found that overdose deaths were more than three times more likely to occur in crack users, and that women who started smoking crack had a 30 percent greater chance of a death as compared to women who did not. Crack use also puts addicts at an increased risk of HIV and viral hepatitis. In a frontal cortex study, crack users demonstrated less ability in learning and memory tasks, even after adjusting for other factors such as age, school performance, mental health, and drug use behaviors, like binge drinking, which have previously been identified as major risk factors for crack addiction. The third factor is whether the price of a cocaine is lower or higher than its crack equivalent. For a given amount of cocaine, crack cocaine is more expensive. Most crack users smoke crack

in addition to using cocaine. To them it is worth it, because even at lower prices, it is the more potent cocaine that they are looking for. Some estimates say that about one quarter of all drug use in the United States starts as crack use. Cocaine and crack are both derivatives of the stimulant, cocaine. Cocaine has the same main psychoactive component as methamphetamine, methamphetamine or meth, and the chemical structures of both cocaine and meth are quite similar. The findings suggest that the important links between crack cocaine use, post-traumatic stress disorder, and chronic illness are likely due to the same underlying reasons, says Dr. Palamar, and are not very likely to be just the by-product of drug use. Not only are they strongly correlated, but they often occur at the same time. The peak of crack use tends to occur in conjunction with the diagnosis of PTSD, and the increase in

lifetime smoking among crack-using people likely precedes their diagnosis of lung cancer.
